Dear Sir,

We beg to express to you, on behalf of the Nobel Foundation, our best congratulations to the award of the Nobel prize in Physiology and Medicine conferred upon you by the Caroline Medico-Chirurgical Institute.

For your information we beg to advise you that the solemn distribution of the prizes for this year will take place at 5 p.m. on December 10th, in the grand Concert Hall in Stockholm. The assignation for the amount of the prize - which should be exchanged one of the following days at the bureau of the Foundation against a bank chque on the same amount - will be handed over by H.M. the King.

The solemnity in the Concert Hall will be followed by a banquet in the City Hall of Stockholm, the Crown Prince /or other member of the Royal family/ presiding, to which the laureates and their wives are invited as guests of honour. An address in homage of the laureates will then be held by a speaker representing the Foundation, and an opportunity is provided for

those of the laureates who may wish it, to answer in a short speech.

On the following day, the 11th of December, it is expected that the laureates and their accompanying wives together with the Board of Directors of the Nobel Foundation and the Chairmen of the different Nobel Committees will be invited by H.M. the King to a banquet in the Royal Palace.

We beg further respectfully to draw your attention to the last clause in § 9 of the previously sent Statutes of the Nobel Foundation regarding an expected lecture on the subject of the work for which the prize has been awarded.

Hoping that it will be possible for you to come to Stockholm for the Nobel festival we should feel much obliged, if you would kindly inform us regarding the date and time of your arrival and the member or members of your family who may be in your company.
